Winemaker Tasting Notes

This wine has developed a full, rich palate that is complemented by layered fruit forward aromas of stone fruit and white apple. The freshness of this wine is transcendent which will allow it to age beyond 5 years

Viticulture

This Chenin blanc originates from a beautiful old, hillside sloping vineyard block, located beside a stream. In 2025 this block shall be listed as an Old Vine block, marking its 35th year in existence.

Its grapes are picked by hand in two tranches to provide variation to the blending components. It also allows for picking once the grapes have achieved their true optimal ripeness, allowing for complexity. Grapes are also picked during the cooler hours of the day to preserve the freshness of the fruit

Appellation : Wine of Origin Stellenbosch

Vine Age : 33 Years

Cultivar : 100% Chenin blanc

Maturation

Initial fermentation of this wine was in a small stainless steel tank. Thereafter the wine was transferred to French oak barrel where it was aged for a period of 8 months. To lend structure to the wine, and garner richness on the palate, lees ageing was utilised.
